STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS24226

This bill provides the Fish and Game Commission authorization to prescribe and administer a trapping education program, adding to the existing authorization for hunter education and archery education programs.

FISCAL NOTE

There is no fiscal impact to the General Fund. There would be a fiscal impact to the fish and game dedicated fund of an estimated \$22,000 reduction in revenue in the first year because the start-up costs to purchase materials and train instructors to initiate a trapping education program is expected to exceed the first year accrual of attendance fees from an estimated 3,500 trapping education participants.
