There are times when the Secretary of State or County Clerk needs an immediate response from a political candidate, campaign treasurer or lobbyist. The same occurs with voters who request an absentee ballot. The quickest way to contact them is generally via e-mail or calling their cellular phone. However, many will not give the Secretary of State or County Clerk that information if it is public record. This legislation protects that information from public disclosure. The rest of the contact information-mailing address, residence address and telephone number are still available to anyone that requests it.
