3	DITION OF A NEW SECTION 63-3622VV, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE AN EXEMPTION
4	FROM THE SALES OR USE TAX ON CERTAIN MATERIALS USED IN CONNECTION WITH A
5	PUBLIC HIGHWAY OR STREET AND TO PROVIDE EXCEPTIONS; AND PROVIDING AN EF-
6	FECTIVE DATE.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 36, Title 63, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a NEW SECTION, to be known and designated as Section 63-3622VV, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

- 63-3622VV. MATERIALS USED FOR PUBLIC HIGHWAYS OR STREETS. (1) There is exempted from the taxes imposed by this chapter sales of materials to a contractor or materials used by a contractor, regardless of whether the materials become a component of real property or improvement or fixture thereto, when the following conditions are met:
 - The materials are used under a contract with a federal, state, county, highway district or city government entity or any political subdivision or agency of such government entity, including contracts for projects qualifying under section 63-3641, Idaho Code; and
 - (b) The primary purpose of the contract is the construction, improvement, replacement or maintenance of a highway, public highway, public street, or street, as defined by section 40-109, Idaho Code, including bridges, traffic control devices, and facilities.
 - (2) The provisions of this section shall not apply to:
 - (a) Property that continues to be owned by the contractor after completion of a contract;
 - (b) Tools or equipment used by the contractor that do not become part of the public highway or street, even if it is consumed as part of the construction process;
 - (c) Any materials used by a private entity to develop any part of a public highway or street that has not yet been dedicated to the public;
 - (d) Any materials that remain the property of public utilities as defined in section 61-129, Idaho Code; and
 - (e) Materials that become part of a water or sewer system.
- SECTION 2. This act shall be in full force and effect on and after Jan-35 uary 1, 2017. 36
