STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS24485

Electronic cigarettes (e-cigarettes) are growing in use in Idaho. These are devices (defined in 39-5702) that aerosolize nicotine (and other substances) into a vapor that is inhaled. While not usually having the particulate problems of burning tobacco, they do have the same addictive potential and many of the same health consequences. In addition, the liquid nicotine used in vaping is highly toxic to toddlers and infants.

Here in Idaho we do not know who sells e-cigarettes or vaping liquid as there is no license or registration. This bill merely adds the sales and distribution of these nicotine delivery devices to the existing no-cost process run by the Department of Health and Welfare for tobacco retailers.

FISCAL NOTE

The Idaho Tobacco Project (Idaho Department of Heath and Welfare) has estimated the cost "not to exceed \$100" for printing and distributing forms.
