

## **STATEMENT OF PURPOSE**

### **RS24599**

This bill would empower schools to evaluate existing laws and rules, and request waivers that would allow them to respond in innovative ways to local needs through the creation of up to ten Innovation Schools around the state each year for five years. Teachers, principals, superintendents and school boards will have the opportunity to receive waivers in exchange for clearly demonstrating student outcomes and meeting well-defined goals.

### **FISCAL NOTE**

A maximum of \$100,000 impact to the general fund each year for five years.
