STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS24603

Appropriates \$6,316,300 to the Public Utilities Commission for fiscal year 2017 and caps the number of authorized full-time equivalent positions at 52. The bill includes funding for the increased costs for health insurance, funding for increases in leased office space, provides for replacement items, and accounts for a decrease in statewide cost allocation. This bill also includes an ongoing 3% merit-based increase in employee compensation for permanent employees and accounts for the 27th payroll. No line items are provided.
