AN ACT

APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND WELFARE FOR THE WEL FARE DIVISION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017; LIMITING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED
 FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS; PROVIDING FOR GENERAL FUND TRANSFERS
 TO THE COOPERATIVE WELFARE FUND; DIRECTING EXPENDITURES FOR TRUSTEE AND
 BENEFIT PAYMENTS; PROVIDING LEGISLATIVE INTENT FOR PROGRAM INTEGRITY;
 AND REQUIRING BIANNUAL REPORTS.

8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

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9 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Health
10 and Welfare for the Welfare Division, the following amounts to be expended
11 according to the designated programs and expense classes, from the listed
12 funds for the period July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017:

SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519,
 Idaho Code, the Department of Health and Welfare for the Welfare Division is
 authorized no more than six hundred thirty-five and fifty-five hundredths
 (635.55) full-time equivalent positions at any point during the period July
 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017, unless specifically authorized by the Gover nor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be notified promptly
 of any increased positions so authorized.

SECTION 3. GENERAL FUND TRANSFERS. As appropriated, the State Con troller shall make transfers from the General Fund to the Cooperative
 Welfare Fund, periodically, as requested by the director of the Department
 of Health and Welfare and approved by the Board of Examiners.

20 SECTION 4. TRUSTEE AND BENEFIT PAYMENTS. Notwithstanding the provi-21 sions of Section 67-3511, Idaho Code, funds budgeted in the trustee and 22 benefit payments expenditure class shall not be transferred to any other 23 expense class during fiscal year 2017.

SECTION 5. PROGRAM INTEGRITY. Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, it is hereby declared to be the intent of the Legislature that the Department of Health and Welfare shall be required to provide those services authorized or mandated by law in each program, only to the extent of funding and available resources appropriated for each budgeted program.

SECTION 6. ACTUAL AND FORECAST DETAIL REPORTING. The Division of Wel-29 30 fare shall deliver the Self-Reliance Programs Forecast biannually to the Legislative Services Office and Division of Financial Management. The re-31 port shall include monthly caseload details for Temporary Assistance for 32 Needy Families (TANF), Child Care, Medicaid, Advanced Premium Tax Credit 33 (APTC), Aid to the Aged, Blind and Disabled, Food Stamps, and Child Support 34 programs. The Self-Reliance Programs Forecast shall also include expendi-35 ture details for all of the named programs with the exception of Medicaid. 36 The format of the report, and any additional information contained therein, 37 shall be determined by the Legislative Services Office and Division of 38 Financial Management. The first report shall be submitted no later than De-39 cember 31, 2016, and the second report shall be submitted no later than June 40 30, 2017. 41
