## STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

## RS24752

This is the Fiscal Year 2017 appropriation for the Children's Programs Division of the Public Schools Educational Support Program in the amount of \$286,915,800, which is an increase of 16.8% from the General Fund and 1.7% overall. This appropriation includes nondiscretionary increases of \$1,212,700 from the General Fund for the Idaho Digital Learning Academy and an increase of \$100,000 from the General Fund for border contracts. There are three line items in this appropriation. Line item 1 provides \$1,000,000 to continue implementation of mastery-based education. Line item 4 provides \$1,000,000 for school districts to provide for professional development for gifted and talented instructors. Line item 8 transfers \$110,000 from the Central Services Division to this division to allow the Idaho Digital Learning Academy to continue the development of an internet-based portal of online coursework.
