4	REGARDING HYBRID VEHICLES AND TO REMOVE A DEFINITION.

- Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:
- 6 SECTION 1. That Section 49-457, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 7 amended to read as follows:
 - 49-457. ELECTRIC VEHICLE FEE—— HYBRID VEHICLE FEE. (1) An electric vehicle fee of one hundred forty dollars (\$140) shall be collected in addition to all other registration fees assessed pursuant to this chapter on each electric vehicle registered. Provided however, the provisions of this subsection shall not apply to neighborhood electric vehicles as defined in sections 49-115 and 49-123, Idaho Code.
 - (2) A hybrid vehicle fee of seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) shall be collected in addition to all other registration fees assessed pursuant to this chapter on each hybrid vehicle registered.
 - (3) All fees provided for in this section shall be deposited to the highway distribution account as established in section 40-701, Idaho Code, and shall be apportioned as provided for in that section.
 - $(4\underline{3})$ For purposes of this chapter, "electric vehicle" means a vehicle powered only by a form of electricity and "hybrid vehicle" means a motor vehicle with a hybrid propulsion system that operates on both an alternative fuel, including electricity, and traditional fuel.
