AN ACT

1 RELATING TO RENEWAL OF JUDGMENT ON LIENS; AMENDING SECTION 10-1111, IDAHO
2 CODE, TO INCREASE THE PERIOD OF TIME A RENEWED JUDGMENT ON A LIEN MAY BE
3 CONTINUED FOR CERTAIN JUDGMENTS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING
4 RETROACTIVE APPLICATION FOR CERTAIN JUDGMENTS.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

7 SECTION 1. That Section 10-1111, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
8 amended to read as follows:

9 10-1111. RENEWAL OF JUDGMENT -- LIEN. (1) Unless the judgment has been
10 satisfied, at any time prior to the expiration of the lien created by sec-
11 tion 10-1110, Idaho Code, or any renewal thereof, the court which entered the
12 judgment, other than a judgment for child support, may, upon motion, renew
13 such judgment. The renewed judgment may be recorded in the same manner as the
14 original judgment, and the lien established thereby shall continue for ~~five~~
15 ten (510) years from the date of judgment.

16 (2) Unless the judgment has been satisfied, and prior to the expiration
17 of the lien created in section 10-1110, Idaho Code, or any renewal thereof,
18 a court that has entered a judgment for child support may, upon motion, renew
19 such judgment. The renewed judgment may be enforced in the same manner as the
20 original judgment, and the lien established thereby shall continue for ten
21 (10) years from the date of the renewed judgment.

22 SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
23 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after
24 its passage and approval, and retroactively to July 1, 2015, and shall apply
25 only to judgments issued on and after July 1, 2015, by a court of competent
26 jurisdiction.
