AN ACT

1 APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE STATE INDEPENDENT LIVING COUNCIL FOR FISCAL  
2 YEAR 2017; LIMITING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT  
3 POSITIONS; AND APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING MONEYS TO THE STATE INDE-  
4 PENDENT LIVING COUNCIL (DED) FUND WITHIN THE STATE INDEPENDENT LIVING  
5 COUNCIL ON JULY 1, 2016, OR AS SOON THEREAFTER AS IS PRACTICABLE.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

8 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Independent Liv-  
9 ing Council, the following amounts to be expended for the designated expense  
10 classes, from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2016, through June 30,

20 SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519,  
21 Idaho Code, the State Independent Living Council is authorized no more than  
22 four (4) full-time equivalent positions at any point during the period July  
23 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017, unless specifically authorized by the Gover-  
24 nor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be notified promptly  
25 of any increased positions so authorized.

27 SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated and the State Controller shall  
28 transfer up to \$89,900 from the Federal Grant Fund to the State Independent  
29 Living Council (Ded) Fund within the State Independent Living Council on  
30 July 1, 2016, or as soon thereafter as is practicable. The purpose of this  
31 transfer is to resolve an outstanding accounting issue surrounding federal  
32 reimbursements that were received and erroneously deposited into the Fed-  
33 eral Grant Fund.
