AN ACT

- 2 APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017; LIMITING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSI-3 TIONS; APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING MONEYS FROM THE REVOLVING DEVEL-4 5 OPMENT FUND TO THE AQUIFER PLANNING AND MANAGEMENT FUND; TRANSFERRING MONEYS FROM THE ECONOMIC RECOVERY RESERVE FUND TO THE SECONDARY AQUIFER 6 PLANNING, MANAGEMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION FUND; TRANSFERRING MONEYS FROM 7 THE GENERAL FUND TO THE SECONDARY AQUIFER PLANNING, MANAGEMENT AND IM-8 PLEMENTATION FUND; TRANSFERRING MONEYS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE 9 MISCELLANEOUS REVENUE FUND FOR DEPOSIT TO THE PRIEST LAKE OUTLET SUBAC-10 COUNT; AND PROVIDING LEGISLATIVE INTENT. 11
- 12 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Water Resources, the following amounts to be expended according to the designated programs and expense classes, from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017:

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SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519, Idaho Code, the Department of Water Resources is authorized no more than one hundred fifty-five (155) full-time equivalent positions at any point during the period July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017, unless specifically authorized by the Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be notified promptly of any increased positions so authorized.

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Water Resources and the State Controller shall transfer \$716,000 from the Revolving Development Fund to the Aquifer Planning and Management Fund, on July
1, 2016, or as soon thereafter as practicable, for the period July 1, 2016,
through June 30, 2017.

SECTION 4. Of the amount appropriated to the Department of Water Resources in Section 1 of this act for the Planning and Technical Services Program from the Economic Recovery Reserve Fund for lump sum, the State Controller shall transfer \$2,500,000 to the Secondary Aquifer Planning, Management and Implementation Fund, on July 1, 2016, or as soon thereafter as practicable, for the period July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017.

SECTION 5. Of the amount appropriated to the Department of Water Resources in Section 1 of this act for the Planning and Technical Services Program from the General Fund for lump sum, the State Controller shall transfer \$5,000,000 to the Secondary Aquifer Planning, Management and Implementation Fund, on July 1, 2016, or as soon thereafter as practicable, for the period July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017.

SECTION 6. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Water Resources and the State Controller shall transfer \$100,400 from the General Fund to the Miscellaneous Revenue Fund, on July 1, 2016, or as soon thereafter as practicable, for the period July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017. Such moneys shall be credited to the Priest Lake Outlet Subaccount.

29 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the Legislature that 30 the Idaho Water Resource Board sell the Pristine Springs property for the ap-31 praised value and that the proceeds be deposited to the General Fund.
