SENATE BILL NO. 1422

AN ACT

1 APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION FOR THE  
2 DIVISION OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2016; AUTHORIZING AND DIRECT-  
3 ING THE ALLOCATION OF FUNDS FOR SPECIFIC PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2016;  
4 APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION FOR THE DIVI-  
5 SION OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017; AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE  
6 ALLOCATION OF FUNDS FOR SPECIFIC PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017; PROVID-  
7 ING LEGISLATIVE INTENT RELATING TO UTILIZATION OF MATCHING FUNDS; EX-  
8 EMPTING THE APPROPRIATION FROM THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 36, TITLE 67,  
9 IDAHO CODE, AND FROM THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 67-3516, IDAHO CODE; PRO-  
10 VIDING LEGISLATIVE INTENT RELATING TO REALLOCATION OF PROJECT SAVINGS;  
11 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

13 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

14 SECTION 1. In addition to the appropriation made in Section 2, Chapter  
15 312, Laws of 2015, and any other appropriation provided for by law, there is  
16 hereby appropriated to the Department of Administration for the Division of  
17 Public Works \$2,897,000 from the Permanent Building Fund, to be expended for  
18 capital outlay, for the period July 1, 2015, through June 30, 2016.

19 SECTION 2. ALLOCATION OF FUNDS FOR SPECIFIC PROJECTS. Moneys appropri-  
20 ated in Section 1 of this act, or so much thereof as in each case may be neces-  
21 sary, shall be used for the purpose of paying the cost of any land, building,  
22 equipment, or the rebuilding, renovation or repair of buildings, installa-  
23 tions, facilities or structures at the places, institutions and agencies,  
24 or their successors, including those listed in this section. The Permanent  
25 Building Fund Advisory Council is hereby authorized and directed to antici-  
26 pate revenues accruing to the Permanent Building Fund for the purpose of un-  
27 dertaking the construction, renovation, repair and acquisitions therein au-  
28 thorized, without delay, and to determine the priority of construction pur-  
29 suant to which the work hereunder will be undertaken.

35 SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Admin-  
36 istration for the Division of Public Works \$26,729,700 from the Permanent  
37 Building Fund, to be expended for capital outlay, for the period July 1,  
38 2016, through June 30, 2017.

1 SECTION 4. ALLOCATION OF FUNDS FOR SPECIFIC PROJECTS. Moneys appropri-  
 2 ated in Section 3 of this act, or so much thereof as in each case may be neces-  
 3 sary, shall be used for the purpose of paying the cost of any land, building,  
 4 equipment, or the rebuilding, renovation or repair of buildings, installa-  
 5 tions, facilities or structures at the places, institutions and agencies,  
 6 or their successors, including those listed in this section. The Permanent  
 7 Building Fund Advisory Council is hereby authorized and directed to antici-  
 8 pate revenues accruing to the Permanent Building Fund for the purpose of un-  
 9 dertaking the construction, renovation, repair and acquisitions therein au-  
 10 thorized, without delay, and to determine the priority of construction pur-  
 11 suant to which the work hereunder will be undertaken.

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29 SECTION 5. UTILIZATION OF MATCHING FUNDS. It is legislative intent that  
 30 the moneys appropriated in this act may be made available for matching any  
 31 allocation of moneys now in existence or hereafter made available by agen-  
 32 cies of the United States and/or private donations; and it is further the ex-  
 33 press intention of the Legislature to authorize the Division of Public Works  
 34 to expend, for the purpose of paying the cost of any land, building, equip-  
 35 ment or the rebuilding, renovation or repair of buildings, moneys appropri-  
 36 ated for public works to various agencies as part of the respective agency  
 37 operating budgets; provided the express approval by the Permanent Building

1 Fund Advisory Council is granted to make application for such moneys in each  
2 instance.

3 SECTION 6. EXEMPTION OF APPROPRIATIONS FROM CERTAIN PROVISIONS. All  
4 appropriations made herein shall be exempt from the provisions of Chapter  
5 36, Title 67, Idaho Code, and Section 67-3516, Idaho Code, but shall be  
6 available for expenditure only after allotment in accordance with the other  
7 provisions of Chapter 35, Title 67, Idaho Code, and all appropriations made  
8 hereunder shall be subject to the provisions of Section 67-5711, Idaho Code,  
9 except as otherwise provided herein.

10 SECTION 7. REALLOCATION OF PROJECT SAVINGS. It is the intent of the Leg-  
11 islature that the Division of Public Works have the flexibility to allocate  
12 any savings or unused appropriation from any capital, line-item project to  
13 any other requested and funded capital projects. The reallocation of such  
14 appropriation must be approved by the Permanent Building Fund Advisory Coun-  
15 cil prior to the funds being spent.

16 SECTION 8. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby  
17 declared to exist, Sections 1 and 2 of this act shall be in full force and ef-  
18 fect on and after passage and approval.
