H 441: Mitch Toryanski, Legal Counsel, Bureau of Occupational Licenses, presented

**H 441**. This legislation amends the Idaho Board of Cosmetology's renewal and reinstatement of license statute. The bill will simplify and standardize reinstatement

of expired licenses.

RS 24451: Kris Ellis, Northwest Career Colleges Federation, presented RS 24451. The

purpose of this proposed legislation is to clarify licensed barber schools as

postsecondary institutions, in order to align with federal regulations.
