

**MINUTES**

Cochair Senator Brackett called the meeting to order at 12:03 p.m. and requested the roll to be called. Members present: Senators Brackett, Crabtree, and Nye; Representatives (Cochair) Palmer, Monks, Kauffman, and Toone. A quorum was present to begin the meeting. Senator Anthon arrived shortly after roll call; absent and excused from the meeting: Senator Winder and Representative Shepherd.

Others in attendance: Legislative Services Office (LSO) committee staff--Katharine Gerrity, Christine Otto, Jennifer Kish; Ramon Hobdey-Sanchez--Idaho Transportation Department (ITD); Skip Smyser; and Jason Kreizenbeck.

Cochair Brackett welcomed Ms. Gerrity and Representative Shepherd to this year's committee. He summarized that last year's committee, while hearing a lot of informative presentations, had not reached any agreed-upon solution(s) and, hence, the committee had requested reauthorization. Cochair Brackett requested that Ms. Gerrity contact the members and set the next meeting's date as early as possible.

Cochair Palmer commented that the members had been given a copy of the reauthorizing resolution ([SCR134](#)) and SECTION 10 from [HB312aaS,aaS](#) (2015). He encouraged the members to review that information to assist with the committee's focus. He also encouraged ITD staff to be a contributing partner in the process, as well as members of the trucking industries. Cochair Palmer requested that the next meeting be set some time after May 15.

Seeing no other business to discuss, Cochair Brackett adjourned the meeting at 12:10 p.m.
