

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS26459

The State Occupational Therapy Licensure Board is proposing legislation to: (1) remove outdated language that limits the number of times an applicant may fail the national examination; (2) clarify language regarding inactive licensure and address the procedure to put a license into inactive status, to renew it, and to return it to active status; (3) eliminate the detailed requirements for the rules prescribing the practices and procedures for supervision; (4) modernize and standardize language regarding renewal and reinstatement and continuing education; and (5) remove the requirement for biennial proof of continuing education.

FISCAL NOTE

There is no impact to the General Fund or the Idaho Bureau of Occupational Licenses' dedicated fund because the proposed legislation will not alter the number of board meetings held each year or require more services to be provided to the State Occupational Therapy Licensure Board.
