1 AN ACT RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE DIVISION OF BUILDING SAFETY FOR FISCAL 2 YEAR 2020; APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE DIVISION OF BUILDING SAFETY FOR 3 FISCAL YEAR 2020; LIMITING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME EQUIVA-4 LENT POSITIONS; AND PROVIDING REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY. 5

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Division of Building Safety the following amounts to be expended according to the designated expense classes from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2019, through June 30, 2020: 10

SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519, Idaho Code, the Division of Building Safety is authorized no more than one hundred forty-four (144.00) full-time equivalent positions at any point during the period July 1, 2019, through June 30, 2020, unless specifically authorized by the Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be notified promptly of any increased positions so authorized.

SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY. There is hereby reappropriated to the Division of Building Safety any unexpended and unencumbered balances appropriated or reappropriated to the Division of Building Safety from the

- State Regulatory Fund for the Trackit9 software system for fiscal year 2019, in an amount not to exceed \$100,000, to be used for nonrecurring expenditures
- related to the Trackit9 software system for the period July 1, 2019, through
- June 30, 2020.
