S 1111:	Rep. Holtzclaw presented S 1111, relating to notarial acts. The legislation proposes granting authorization for notaries to execute notarial acts through technological means, also known as remote notarization. The legislation also requires counties to accept electronically notarized records. Rep. Holtzclaw introduced Chad Houck, Deputy Secretary of State, Secretary of State's Office, to answer committee questions. Mr. Houck explained the Electronic Notarization Act was passed last year and this allows for electronic signatures to be obtained.

S 1127:	Rep. Hartgen presented S 1127 , relating to the Interstate Agreement on Detainers. The legislation changes the "director of correction" from the Director of the Department of Correction to the Attorney General or his designee. This change aligns Idaho Code with departmental practice and is supported by the Governor's office, the Attorney General, and the Director of the Department of Correction.	
MOTION:	Rep. Palmer made a motion to send S 1127 to the floor with a DO PASS recommendation. Motion carried by voice vote. Rep. Hartgen will sponsor the bill on the floor.
