STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS28003 / H0636

This is the FY 2021 original appropriation bill for the State Treasurer. It appropriates a total of \$4,336,500 and caps the number of authorized full-time equivalent positions at 26.00. For benefit costs, the bill maintains the current appropriated amount for health insurance at \$11,650 per eligible FTP and temporarily removes funding for the employer's sick leave contribution rate. The bill also provides funding for the equivalent of a 2% change in employee compensation for permanent state employees. Also included are adjustments to pay the Office of Information Technology Services for security software and data center office space located at the Chinden Campus. The ongoing General Fund appropriation is reduced by 2%. Additionally, Section 3 of the bill limits the amount that may be spent annually on bank service fees.
