 2 RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE REGULATORY BOARDS; APPROPRIATING MON-  
 3 EYS TO THE REGULATORY BOARDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021; LIMITING THE NUMBER  
 4 OF AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS; PROVIDING REAPPROPRIA-  
 5 TION AUTHORITY FOR A DATABASE UPGRADE; PROVIDING REAPPROPRIATION AU-  
 6 THORITY FOR CONSTRUCTION AND MOVING EXPENSES; APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL  
 7 MONEYS TO THE BUREAU OF OCCUPATIONAL LICENSES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020; AND  
 8 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

10 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Regulatory Boards the  
 11 following amounts to be expended according to the designated programs and  
 12 expense classes from the listed fund for the period July 1, 2020, through  
 13 June 30, 2021:

10 SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519,  
 11 Idaho Code, each of the programs in the Regulatory Boards is authorized no  
 12 more than the number of full-time equivalent positions listed below at any  
 13 point during the period July 1, 2020, through June 30, 2021, unless specifi-  
 14 cally authorized by the Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations Commit-  
 15 tee will be notified promptly of any increased positions so authorized.

21 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY FOR A DATABASE UPGRADE. There is  
 22 hereby reappropriated to the Regulatory Boards for the Bureau of Occupa-  
 23 tional Licenses any unexpended and unencumbered balances appropriated to  
 24 the Regulatory Boards for the Bureau of Occupational Licenses from the State  
 25 Regulatory Fund for the upgrade of its database for fiscal year 2020, in an  
 26 amount not to exceed \$1,021,000 from the State Regulatory Fund, to be used  
 27 for nonrecurring expenditures related to the upgrade of its database for the  
 28 period July 1, 2020, through June 30, 2021. The State Controller shall con-  
 29 firm the reappropriation amount, by fund, expense class, and program, with  
 30 the Legislative Services Office prior to processing the reappropriation  
 31 authorized herein.

32 SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY FOR CONSTRUCTION AND MOVING EX-  
 33 PENSES. There is hereby reappropriated to the Regulatory Boards for the Bu-  
 34 reau of Occupational Licenses any unexpended and unencumbered balances ap-  
 35 propriated to the Regulatory Boards for the Bureau of Occupational Licenses  
 36 from the State Regulatory Fund for construction and moving expenses related  
 37 to the move to the Chinden Campus for fiscal year 2020, in an amount not to  
 38 exceed \$1,352,000 from the State Regulatory Fund, to be used for nonrecur-  
 39 ring expenditures related to construction and moving to the Chinden Campus  
 40 for the period July 1, 2020, through June 30, 2021. The State Controller  
 41 shall confirm the reappropriation amount, by fund, expense class, and pro-

1 gram, with the Legislative Services Office prior to processing the reappro-  
2 priation authorized herein.

3 SECTION 5. In addition to the appropriation made in Section 1, Chap-  
4 ter 140, Laws of 2019, and any other appropriation provided by law, there is  
5 hereby appropriated to the Bureau of Occupational Licenses within the Reg-  
6 ulatory Boards \$1,352,000 from the State Regulatory Fund to be expended for  
7 operating expenditures for the period July 1, 2019, through June 30, 2020.

8 SECTION 6. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby  
9 declared to exist, Section 5 of this act shall be in full force and effect on  
10 and after passage and approval.
