BY JUDICIARY AND RULES COMMITTEE

A SENATE RESOLUTION
STATING FINDINGS OF THE SENATE AND PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF RULE 19 OF
THE RULES OF THE SENATE TO PROVIDE FOR APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS OF STAND-
ING COMMITTEES, TO PROVIDE FOR APPOINTMENT OF THE CHAIR AND VICE-CHAIF
OF COMMITTEES, AND TO REVISE PROVISIONS REGARDING THE PRINTING COMMIT-
TEE.

Be It Resolved by the Senate of the State of Idaho:

WHEREAS, the Senate deems it necessary and desirable that Rule 19 of the Rules of the Senate be amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Senate, assembled in the Second Regular Session of the Sixty-fifth Idaho Legislature, that Rule 19 of the Rules of the Senate shall be amended to read as follows:

RULE 19

Committee Assignments.-- (A) The <u>members of the</u> following standing committees shall be appointed by the leadership under the direction of the President Pro Tempore, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate; the number of members on each committee shall be fixed in the order of appointment, and such order shall be read into the Journal; provided that the President Pro Tempore shall appoint a majority of each committee and the <u>chairman chair and vice-chair</u> of each committee from the membership of the political party having a majority in the Senate:

22 Agricultural Affairs
23 Commerce and Human Resources
24 Education
25 Finance
26 Health and Welfare
27 Judiciary and Rules

Local Government and Taxation

29 Resources and Environment

30 State Affairs31 Transportation

Printing Committee. -- (B) The Judiciary and Rules Committee shall constitute and perform all duties of a printing and engrossing and enrolling committee in the Senate, including the execution of a contract for printing of the session laws to be submitted to the Senate by resolution for approval; and the Secretary of the Senate shall serve as an ex officio member of said committee. The Joint Printing Committee shall prepare a brief written report of its recommendations, which shall be delivered to the Senate

<u>Judiciary and Rules Committee</u>, and shall perform such other functions of administration of Senate affairs as shall be assigned to it by the President.

Absence of Chairman Chair.-- (C) At any committee meeting, in the absence of the chairman chair, the acting chairman chair shall be the vice-chairmanchair. If both chairman chair and vice-chairmanchair be absent, then the other committee members, in the order listed on the committee roster, shall have the right to serve as acting chairman chair.

Chairman Chair Voting. -- (D) On all standing committees and the Committee of the Whole, the chairman chair shall be entitled to vote at all times.
