SCR 123:	Senator Todd Lakey presented SCR 123. This legislation establishes the State of Idaho's commitment to request federal grants to expand the Boise Veterans Cemetery and fund the renovation of multiple life safety projects at the Lewiston and Pocatello Veterans Homes. The resolution is necessary so the Idaho Division of Veterans Services (IDVS) can proceed with the application for federal grant funds.
MOTION:	Rep. Kauffman made a motion to send SCR 123 to the floor with a DO PASS recommendation. Motion carried by voice vote. Rep. Kauffman will sponsor the bill on the floor.
SCR 133:	Rep. Syme presented SCR 133 . This Resolution proclaims the month of May as Hidden Heroes Month, in conjunction with Military Appreciation Month. SCR 133 is an expression of support for military and Veteran caregivers.
	Jeannette Davidson-Mayer, Our Centeral Command Post, spoke in support of the Resolution. She pointed out the challenges of caring for the wounded, ill, or injured American heroes. She also mentioned an alarming number of veteran and military caregivers suffer debilitating mental, physical, and emotional effects as a result of their caregiving duties.
MOTION:	Rep. DeMordaunt made a motion to send SCR 133 to the floor with a DO PASS recommendation. Motion carried by voice vote . Rep. Syme will sponsor the bill on the floor.
