HOUSE BILL NO. 288

2 RELATING TO THE DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION CAUSING TARGETED RESIDENTIAL  
3 PICKETING; AMENDING CHAPTER 64, TITLE 18, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION  
4 OF A NEW SECTION 18-6411, IDAHO CODE, TO PROHIBIT THE DISCLOSURE OF CER-  
5 TAIN INFORMATION CAUSING TARGETED RESIDENTIAL PICKETING, TO PROVIDE A  
6 PENALTY, AND TO DEFINE A TERM; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

8 SECTION 1. That Chapter 64, Title 18, Idaho Code, be, and the same is  
9 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a NEW SECTION, to be known and des-  
10 ignated as Section 18-6411, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

11 18-6411. DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION CAUSING TARGETED RESIDENTIAL  
12 PICKETING. (1) It shall be unlawful to publish, post, disseminate, or dis-  
13 close an individual's residential address, or other information identifying  
14 the specific location of an individual's residence or dwelling place, with  
15 the intent to harass, intimidate, or cause another individual to engage in  
16 targeted residential picketing.

17 (2) A violation of subsection (1) of this section shall be a misde-  
18 meanor.

19 (3) As used in this section, "targeted residential picketing" means  
20 intentionally engaging in picketing or other demonstration on the street  
21 or sidewalk in front of a person's residence or dwelling place, or on the  
22 street or sidewalk in front of the adjacent residence or dwelling place,  
23 with the intent to harass, annoy, or alarm another person. "Targeted resi-  
24 dential picketing" does not include picketing or demonstrating in front of  
25 a residence or dwelling place used as the principal place of business of an  
26 individual.

27 SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby  
28 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after its  
29 passage and approval.
