STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS28841 / H0338

This is the FY 2022 original appropriation bill for the Office of the State Controller. It appropriates a total of \$22,249,600 and caps the number of authorized full-time equivalent positions at 101.00. For benefit costs, the bill maintains the current appropriated amount for health insurance at \$11,650 per eligible FTP, extends the holiday for the employer's sick leave contribution rate for another year, and restores funding for the employer's unemployment insurance contribution rate. The bill also provides funding for the equivalent of a 2% change in employee compensation for permanent state employees. The bill funds five line items, which provide 4.00 FTP for four new positions to support state agencies in the implementation of the budget and procurement modules of Luma; \$375,000 to create a meeting notice website for all state agency public meetings; \$3,000,000 for an e-procurement system and phase 1 of an enterprise resource planning (ERP) study for the four institutions of higher education; \$2,300,000 in federal COVID-19 relief funds for compliance and audit requirements of the U.S. CARES Act; and a \$3,000,000 cash transfer from the General Fund to the dedicated Business Information Infrastructure Fund to implement the project funded in line item 4.
