STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS28950 / H0383

This is the FY 2022 original appropriation bill for the Office of the Lieutenant Governor. It appropriates a total of \$183,100 and caps the number of authorized full-time equivalent positions at 3.00. The bill maintains the current appropriated amount for health insurance at \$11,650 per eligible FTP, extends the holiday for the employer's sick leave contribution rate for another year, and restores funding for the employer's unemployment insurance contribution rate. The bill also provides funding for the equivalent of a 2% change in employee compensation for permanent state employees. The bill provides an exemption from Section 67-3511 (1) and (3), Idaho Code, allowing unlimited transfers between object codes.
