HOUSE BILL NO. 501

BY JUDICIARY, RULES AND ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE

AN ACT

1 RELATING TO THE IDAHO STATE CAPITOL; AMENDING SECTION 67-1602, IDAHO CODE,
2 TO REVISE PROVISIONS REGARDING THE ALLOCATION AND CONTROL OF SPACE IN
3 THE CAPITOL BUILDING AND TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS; AND DECLARING
4 AN EMERGENCY.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

7 SECTION 1. That Section 67-1602, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
8 amended to read as follows:

9 67-1602. IDAHO STATE CAPITOL -- ALLOCATION AND CONTROL OF SPACE. The
10 space within the interior of the capitol building shall be allocated and con-
11 trolled as follows:

12 (1) Public space. The interior within the rotunda~~;~~ the hallways in
13 the basement, including the underground atrium wings, and on the first and
14 second floors~~;~~ the restrooms located adjacent thereto~~;~~ the elevators~~;~~
15 and the stairways between the basement, including the underground atrium
16 wings, and the first, second, third, and fourth floors (excepting the inte-
17 rior stairways between the third and fourth floors within the legislative
18 chambers)~~;~~ shall be space within the capitol building open to the public
19 ("public space"). Subject to this chapter, the director of the department of
20 administration shall maintain all public space.

21 (2) Executive department. The governor shall determine the use and al-
22 locate the space within the second floor. The director of the department of
23 administration shall maintain such space.

24 (3) Legislative department. The legislative department shall deter-
25 mine the use of the space on the first, third, and fourth floors as well as the
26 basement, which basement shall include the underground atrium wings. All
27 space within the first, third, and fourth floors and the basement shall be
28 allocated by the presiding officers of the senate and the house of repre-
29 sentatives. Except as otherwise provided in subsection (1) of this section,
30 the presiding officers shall maintain such space and provide equipment and
31 furniture thereto, provided however, that the presiding officers may con-
32 tract with the director of the department of administration to maintain such
33 space and provide equipment and furniture thereto.

34 SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
35 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after its
36 passage and approval.
