RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION 2 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023; APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS 3 AND RECREATION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023; LIMITING THE NUMBER OF AUTHO-4 RIZED FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS; EXEMPTING THE APPROPRIATION FROM 5 PROGRAM TRANSFER LIMITATIONS; PROVIDING REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY; 6 APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECRE-7 ATION FOR THE CAPITAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022; AND 8 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. 9

10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

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SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Parks and 11 Recreation the following amounts to be expended according to the designated 12 programs and expense classes from the listed funds for the period July 1, 13 2022, through June 30, 2023: 14

SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519,
Idaho Code, the Department of Parks and Recreation is authorized no more than
one hundred seventy and ninety-seven hundredths (170.97) full-time equiva lent positions at any point during the period July 1, 2022, through June 30,
2023, unless specifically authorized by the Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be notified promptly of any increased positions
so authorized.

SECTION 3. EXEMPTIONS FROM PROGRAM TRANSFER LIMITATIONS. Notwith-16 standing the provisions of Section 67-3511(2), Idaho Code, trustee and 17 benefit payments appropriated for grants in the Management Services Program 18 19 may be transferred to capital outlay in the Capital Development Program or to capital outlay in the Park Operations Program to reflect grants awarded to 20 the Department of Parks and Recreation for the period July 1, 2022, through 21 June 30, 2023. Legislative appropriations shall not be transferred from one 22 23 fund to another fund unless expressly approved by the Legislature.

SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY. There is hereby reappropriated 24 to the Department of Parks and Recreation any unexpended and unencumbered 25 balances appropriated or reappropriated to the Department of Parks and 26 27 Recreation for the Capital Development Program for fiscal year 2022 to be used for nonrecurring expenditures in the Capital Development Program for 28 the period July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023. The Office of the State Con-29 troller shall confirm the reappropriation amount, by fund, expense class, 30 and program, with the Legislative Services Office prior to processing the 31 reappropriation authorized herein. 32

33 SECTION 5. In addition to the appropriation made in Section 1, Chap-4 ter 152, Laws of 2021, and any other appropriation provided by law, there is 5 hereby appropriated to the Department of Parks and Recreation in the Capi-4 tal Development Program \$215,000 from the Parks and Recreation Fund to be ex-5 pended for capital outlay for the period July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022, 5 for delegated construction projects.

39 SECTION 6. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby 40 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after its 41 passage and approval.

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
