This is the FY 2023 original appropriation bill for the Public Schools Educational Support Program's Division of Teachers.

This division provides state and federal funding support for grades K-12 for instructional and pupil service staff salaries and benefits, and other programs specific to certificated instructors in Idaho's school districts and public charter schools.

This bill provides statutory-based funding adjustments for the Career Ladder, Master Educator Premiums, and math and science requirements. The bill also includes onetime federal funds for additional compensation for teachers and pupil service staff.
