2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND URGING THE GOVERNOR AND THE STATE OF
3 IDAHO TO RECOGNIZE MISSION43, ITS EFFORTS, AND ITS LEADERSHIP IN ENSUR-
4 ING THAT MILITARY VETERANS, THEIR SPOUSES, AND THEIR CHILDREN ARE WEL-
5 COME AND GIVEN OPPORTUNITY TO PURSUE THE AMERICAN DREAM IN IDAHO.

6 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

7 WHEREAS, the State of Idaho is committed to military veterans, military
8 spouses, and their families; and

9 WHEREAS, Mission43, named after the forty-third state, has taken on the
10 mission of making Idaho a premier destination for veterans and their fami-
11 lies during and after their service; and

12 WHEREAS, the State of Idaho acknowledges Mission43 and the efforts and
13 investments to provide servicemen, servicewomen, and military spouses op-
14 portunities to succeed in Idaho after the military through the pillars of ed-
15 ucation, employment, and engagement; and

16 WHEREAS, Mission43 has provided more than 1,000 veterans and spouses
17 advice and access to exclusive programs to help members maximize their mili-
18 tary benefits, excel academically, and grow professionally; and

19 WHEREAS, Mission43 has provided more than 1,200 veterans access to pro-
20 grams that give veterans and their spouses the resources needed to succeed in
21 their transition to the civilian Idaho workforce and advance beyond levels
22 of underemployment; and

23 WHEREAS, Mission43 has organized and hosted meaningful events, provid-
24 ing opportunities for veterans to stay active, find purpose, and connect,
25 having led to more than 10,000 engagements for veterans and civilians in var-
26 ious communities across the State of Idaho; and

27 WHEREAS, Mission43 has placed this mission on itself for the benefit
28 of the State of Idaho through the generosity of Idaho citizens and has cre-
29 ated these ongoing and growing successes without the use of federal or state
30 funds.

31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Second Regular Ses-
32 sion of the Sixty-sixth Idaho Legislature, the House of Representatives and
33 the Senate concurring therein, that we urge the Governor and the State of
34 Idaho to recognize Mission43, its efforts, and its leadership in ensuring
35 that military veterans, their spouses, and their children are given welcome
36 and opportunity to pursue the American dream in Idaho.
