5 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

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6 WHEREAS, the Legislature pursuant to Section 67-5224, Idaho Code, must
7 approve certain administrative rules that impose a fee or charge by adoption
8 of a concurrent resolution before the rules become effective; and

9 WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority under the provisions 10 of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, to reject executive agency rules that are not 11 consistent with legislative intent; and

12 WHEREAS, the House Health and Welfare Committee and the Senate Health 13 and Welfare Committee reviewed rules that impose a fee or charge adopted by 14 the Department of Health and Welfare as set forth in Docket No. 16-0000-15 2100F; and

WHEREAS, the House Health and Welfare Committee and the Senate Health and Welfare Committee reviewed rules that impose a fee or charge adopted by the Division of Occupational and Professional Licenses that relate to health care as set forth in Docket No. 24-0000-2100F and found these rules to be consistent with legislative intent and should therefore be approved by the committees to which this docket was assigned; and

22 WHEREAS, the Legislature finds that it is in the public interest to 23 adopt this resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Second Regular Ses-24 sion of the Sixty-sixth Idaho Legislature, the House of Representatives and 25 the Senate concurring therein, that fee rules adopted by the Department of 26 Health and Welfare, as set forth in Docket No. 16-0000-2100F, pursuant to 27 the Administrative Procedure Act and submitted through the Office of Rules 28 Coordinator to the Legislature for review during the 2022 legislative ses-29 sion and reviewed by the House Health and Welfare Committee and the Senate 30 31 Health and Welfare Committee, be, and the same are approved.
