- 5 Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Idaho:

6 WHEREAS, the House of Representatives finds that the American Rescue 7 Plan Act (ARPA), P.L. 117-2, as passed by Congress and signed into law, al-8 located \$1,094,018,353 to the State of Idaho for the State Fiscal Recovery 9 Fund; and

WHEREAS, projects associated with the State Fiscal Recovery Fund must
 be obligated by December 31, 2024, and expended by December 31, 2026; and

12 WHEREAS, one of the four allowable uses of the State Fiscal Recovery13 Fund includes COVID-19 mitigation and prevention; and

14 WHEREAS, Idaho's State Employee Health Insurance Fund has been neg-15 atively impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic due to the unexpected costs of 16 testing, treatment, and in some cases hospitalization that were otherwise 17 unanticipated by premium payments by the employer and employee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the House of Representatives, assembled in the Second Regular Session of the Sixty-sixth Idaho Legislature, that \$25,000,000 be obligated from the State Fiscal Recovery Fund to rebuild reserves in the State Employee Health Insurance Fund.
