| 7 | passed by Congress and signed into law; and |
| 8 | WHEREAS, ARPA allocated \$1,094,018,353 to the State of Idaho for the |
| 9 | State Fiscal Recovery Fund; and |
| 10 | WHEREAS, projects associated with the State Fiscal Recovery Fund must |
| 11 | be obligated by December 31, 2024, and expended by December 31, 2026; and |
| 12 | WHEREAS, one of the four allowable uses of the State Fiscal Recovery |
| 13 | Fund is to support vital wastewater infrastructure projects; and |
| 14 | WHEREAS, the Idaho Department of Correction has requested \$10,000,000 |
| 15 | in ARPA funds to upgrade wastewater lagoons serving the South Boise Complex. |
