## SENATE BILL NO. 1384

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND WELFARE FOR 2 FISCAL YEAR 2023; APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND 3 WELFARE FOR THE DIVISIONS OF SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT AND PREVENTION, 4 5 MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES, AND PSYCHIATRIC HOSPITALIZATION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023; LIMITING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSI-6 TIONS; PROVIDING FOR GENERAL FUND TRANSFERS TO THE COOPERATIVE WELFARE 7 FUND; DIRECTING EXPENDITURES FOR TRUSTEE AND BENEFIT PAYMENTS; PRO-8 VIDING REQUIREMENTS FOR PROGRAM INTEGRITY; LIMITING THE TRANSFER OF 9 10 LEGISLATIVE APPROPRIATIONS; CLARIFYING RESPONSIBILITY FOR EDUCATION OF CERTAIN CHILDREN IN STATE CARE; DIRECTING AN INTERAGENCY PAYMENT 11 FOR A JUVENILE DETENTION CLINICIANS CONTRACT; PROVIDING REQUIREMENTS 12 REGARDING FUNDING FOR BEHAVIORAL HEALTH COMMUNITY CRISIS CENTERS; PRO-13 VIDING EXEMPTIONS FROM PROGRAM TRANSFER LIMITATIONS; APPROPRIATING 14 15 ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE DIVISION OF MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022; PROVIDING REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY; APPROPRIATING ADDI-16 TIONAL MONEYS TO THE DIVISION OF PSYCHIATRIC HOSPITALIZATION FOR FISCAL 17 YEAR 2022; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. 18

19 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Health and
 Welfare the following amounts to be expended according to the designated
 programs and expense classes from the listed funds for the period July 1,
 2022, through June 30, 2023:

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SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519, Idaho Code, each of the programs in the Department of Health and Welfare listed below is authorized no more than the following number of full-time equivalent positions at any point during the period July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023, unless specifically authorized by the Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be notified promptly of any increased positions so authorized.

SECTION 3. GENERAL FUND TRANSFERS. As appropriated, the Office of the State Controller shall periodically make transfers from the General Fund to the Cooperative Welfare Fund as requested by the director of the Department of Health and Welfare and approved by the Board of Examiners.

SECTION 4. TRUSTEE AND BENEFIT PAYMENTS. Notwithstanding the provi sions of Section 67-3511, Idaho Code, funds appropriated in the trustee and
 benefit payments expense class shall not be transferred to any other expense
 classes during fiscal year 2023.

SECTION 5. PROGRAM INTEGRITY. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the Department of Health and Welfare shall be required to provide those services authorized or mandated by law in each program, only to the extent of funding and available resources appropriated for each budgeted program.

SECTION 6. LIMITING TRANSFER OF LEGISLATIVE APPROPRIATIONS. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 67-3511, Idaho Code, Cooperative Welfare (General) Fund moneys appropriated to the Divisions of Mental Health Services and Psychiatric Hospitalization may be transferred between divisions but shall not be transferred to any other division or program within the Department of Health and Welfare without legislative approval.

SECTION 7. EDUCATIONAL NEEDS. The Department of Health and Welfare 33 shall be responsible for the educational needs of school-age children placed 34 in its custody by the courts for either child protective issues or mental 35 health issues. If the department places a child in a licensed residential 36 treatment facility that includes a nonpublic accredited school, and it is 37 determined by the department that it is in the best interests of the child 38 39 to be educated at the residential treatment facility, then it is the responsibility of the department to pay for such education per student, per 40 educational day. Other Idaho state agencies shall not be precluded from 41 exercising their responsibility to ensure a free and appropriate education 42 for these students within the requirements of federal disability law. 1 fiscal impact of this section is included within existing department base
2 appropriations.

3 SECTION 8. INTERAGENCY PAYMENT FOR JUVENILE DETENTION CLINICIANS CON-4 TRACT. No later than July 16, 2022, the Children's Mental Health Program 5 shall make an interagency payment of \$327,000 from the Cooperative Welfare 6 (General) Fund to the Department of Juvenile Corrections to be used for the 7 purchase of contract clinician services with juvenile detention facilities 8 in Idaho for the period July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023.

9 SECTION 9. BEHAVIORAL HEALTH COMMUNITY CRISIS CENTERS. The seven behavioral health community crisis centers shall submit records that indicate 10 the levels of funding support by fund source. The format of the report and 11 the information included therein shall be determined by the Legislative 12 Services Office Budget and Policy Analysis Division. The contents of these 13 14 reports shall aid in providing a clearer understanding of the financial situations of the behavioral health community crisis centers. These reports 15 shall be submitted to the Legislative Services Office Budget and Policy 16 Analysis Division no later than December 31, 2022. 17

SECTION 10. EXEMPTIONS FROM PROGRAM TRANSFER LIMITATIONS. The Community Hospitalization Program is hereby exempted from the provisions of Section 67-3511(2), Idaho Code, allowing unlimited transfers into the Community Hospitalization Program from other programs within the Department of Health and Welfare for all moneys appropriated to it for the period July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023.

SECTION 11. In addition to the appropriation made in Section 1, Chapter 188, Laws of 2021, and any other appropriation provided for by law, there is hereby appropriated to the Department of Health and Welfare Division of Mental Health Services \$15,000,000 from the Cooperative Welfare (General) Fund to be expended for the period July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022.

SECTION 12. REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY. There is hereby reappropriated 29 to the Children's Mental Health Program any unexpended and unencumbered 30 balances appropriated to the Children's Mental Health Program from the 31 Cooperative Welfare (General) Fund for the purpose of psychiatric residen-32 tial treatment facilities for fiscal year 2022, in an amount not to exceed 33 \$15,000,000, to be used for nonrecurring expenditures related to psychi-34 atric residential treatment facilities for the period July 1, 2022, through 35 June 30, 2023. The Office of the State Controller shall confirm the reappro-36 37 priation amount, by fund, expense class, and program, with the Legislative Services Office prior to processing the reappropriation authorized herein. 38

39 SECTION 13. In addition to the appropriation made in Section 1, Chap-40 ter 188, Laws of 2021, and any other appropriation provided for by law, there 41 is hereby appropriated to the Department of Health and Welfare for the Divi-42 sion of Psychiatric Hospitalization \$4,573,200 from the Cooperative Welfare 43 (General) Fund for capital outlay, of which \$1,845,000 shall be for State Hospital North and \$2,728,200 shall be for State Hospital South, for the period July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022.

3 SECTION 14. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby

4 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after its

5 passage and approval.
