STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS29805 / S1393

This is the FY 2023 original appropriation bill for the Public Utilities Commission. It appropriates a total of \$6,975,400 and caps the number of authorized full-time equivalent positions at 49.00. For benefit costs, the bill increases the appropriated amount for health insurance by \$850 to \$12,500 per eligible full time FTP, includes a one-year holiday of unemployment insurance, and adjusts workers' compensation amounts. The bill also provides funding for permanent employees for the equivalent of a 3% salary structure shift and provides \$1.25 per hour per eligible employee to be distributed based on merit for change in employee compensation.
