Vice Chairman Cannon called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

MOTION: **Rep. Burns** made a motion to approve the minutes from February 6, 2024 and February 7, 2024. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

RS 31287: **Rep. Moyle** presented **RS 31287** and thanked several parties for their work on this proposed legislation. Rep. Moyle stated **RS 31287** would do what is best for schools and provide tax relief. The proposed legislation would lower income tax, provide tax relief, allow school districts to use this money for Plant Facilities Levies and removes the August date for school levy elections. Rep. Moyle remarked the money provided to schools can only be used for teaching facilities and not for facilities such as gymnasiums. Responding to questions from the committee, Rep. Moyle stated the Governor is appointing an executive officer of the state board for greater accountability.

MOTION: **Rep. Ehlers** made a motion to introduce **RS 31287**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**

ADJOURN: There being no further business to come before the committee, the meeting adjourned at 9:07 a.m.
