



HEALTHCARE SPENDING


Orange = National GDP


Orange = National GDP Blue = Idaho GSP

IDAHO **HEALTHCARE SPENDING** COMPARISON



MEDICAID:

\$12,397 per year

(FY24 \$4.5 billion budget divided by 363,000 enrollees.)



STATE EMPLOYEE HEALTH PLAN:

\$14,393 per year

(FY24 Employer/Employee traditional plan premium. State covers 93% of the premium cost.)

GOVERNMENT PAYERS – UPPER PAYMENT LIMIT (UPL)
