


STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS24003

The Idaho Board of Pharmacy administers the regulatory provisions of the state's Uniform Controlled Substance Act. If any substance is designated, rescheduled, or deleted as a controlled substance under federal law and notice thereof is given to the Board, the Board shall similarly control the substance under this Act after the expiration of thirty (30) days from publication in the Federal Register of a final order designating a substance as a controlled substance or rescheduling or deleting a substance, unless within that thirty (30) day period, the Board objects to inclusion, rescheduling, or deletion. On September 11, 2015, the Drug Enforcement Administration removed [123I]ioflupane from Schedule II of the Controlled Substances Act, and this bill mirrors that federal law change.

FISCAL NOTE

This proposal is not expected to have any fiscal impact to the state.



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
