Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Section 67-7127, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 67-7127. USE OF MONEYS IN ACCOUNT. The board shall administer the motorbike recreation account. The moneys derived from this account shall be used as follows:
- (1) Each county with a bona fide off-highway vehicle (OHV) program shall be entitled to receive from the department eighty-five percent (85%) of the moneys generated from that county during the certificate of number period. Purchasers of OHV stickers may designate the county to receive the funds. Moneys may be used to grant match or for staff and maintenance equipment. For counties with a single-track ATV/UTV program, moneys may be used for a trail maintenance agreement with the U.S. forest service, trailheads with restrooms and loading ramps, comprehensive trail mapping systems, a strategic trail maintenance program, organized rides and potential trail maintenance and development programs with other counties, and development of: an OHV park, RV park and hookups, education and training area and a designated kids "safe ride" area.
  - (2) Remaining moneys in the account may be used:
  - $(\frac{1}{a})$  For the securing of special leases or permits, or for the actual purchase of land under private, state or federal ownership to be used for recreational off-highway vehicle activity;
  - (2b) For the securing, maintenance, construction or development of trails and other recreational facilities for off-highway vehicle use on state and federal lands;
  - (3c) To finance the formulation and implementation under the board's direction of an off-the-road rider education program.
  - (4d) To acquire applicable federal matching funds.
