2	RELATING TO TELEHEALTH SERVICES; AMENDING CHAPTER 57, TITLE 54, IDAHO CODE,
3	BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 54-5714, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE FOR RE-
4	IMBURSEMENT OF TELEHEALTH SERVICES AND TO DEFINE A TERM.
5	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

- SECTION 1. That Chapter 57, Title 54, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a $\underline{\text{NEW SECTION}}$, to be known and designated as Section 54-5714, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:
- 54-5714. TELEHEALTH REIMBURSEMENT. (1) Telehealth services identified by current procedural terminology (CPT) or healthcare common procedure coding system (HCPCS) codes as eligible for coverage under medicare and regulations adopted thereunder shall be eligible for coverage under:
 - (a) Any policy or certificate of insurance that provides hospital, medical or long-term care insurance;
 - (b) Any plan or program offered by a managed care organization that provides basic health care services or mental health services; and
 - (c) Any plan governed by chapter 40, title 41, Idaho Code.
- (2) For purposes of this section, "medicare" shall have the same meaning as provided in section 41-4402, Idaho Code.
