Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 48, Title 31, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a $\underline{\text{NEW SECTION}}$, to be known and designated as Section 31-4820, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

- 31-4820. CALL LOCATION INFORMATION OF TELECOMMUNICATIONS DEVICES IN EMERGENCY SITUATIONS -- TELECOMMUNICATIONS -- CARRIERS -- IDAHO STATE POLICE DATABASE -- LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY ACCESS. (1) Upon request of a law enforcement agency, a wireless telecommunications carrier shall provide call location information concerning the telecommunications device of the user to the requesting law enforcement agency in order to respond to a call for emergency services or in an emergency situation that involves the risk of death or serious physical harm.
- (2) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, nothing in this section prohibits a wireless telecommunications carrier from establishing protocols by which the carrier could voluntarily disclose call location information.
- (3) No cause of action shall lie in any court against any wireless telecommunications carrier, its officers, employees, agents or other specified persons for providing call location information while acting in good faith and in accordance with the provisions of this section.
- (4) No provider or seller of wireless telecommunications service shall be liable in any court under a cause of action associated with the inability to locate or ping the device due to the absence of emergency communications systems equipment in the area.
- (5) All wireless telecommunications carriers registered to do business in the state of Idaho or submitting to the jurisdiction thereof and all resellers of wireless telecommunications services shall submit their emergency contact information to the Idaho state police in order to facilitate requests from a law enforcement agency for call location information in accordance with this section. This contact information must be submitted annually by June 15 or immediately upon any change in contact information.
- (6) The Idaho state police shall maintain a database containing emergency contact information for all wireless telecommunications carriers registered to do business in the state of Idaho and shall make the information immediately available upon request to all public safety answer points in the state.

1 (7) Rules shall be promulgated by the director of the Idaho state police 2 in compliance with chapter 52, title 67, Idaho Code, to fulfill the require-3 ments of this section no later than July 1, 2017.
