SENATE BILL NO. 1209

2 RELATING TO GENERAL POWERS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF COMMUNITY COLLEGE DIS-
3 TRICTS; AMENDING SECTION 33-2107, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE CORRECT TERMI-
4 NOLOGY, TO CLARIFY CERTAIN POWERS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF EACH COM-
5 MUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT AND TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

7 SECTION 1. That Section 33-2107, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
8 amended to read as follows:

9 33-2107. GENERAL POWERS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES. The board of
10 trustees of each junior community college district shall have the power:

11 (1-) To adopt ~~rules~~ policies and regulations for its own government and
12 the government of the college;

13 (2-) To employ legal counsel and other professional~~7~~ and nonprofes-
14 sional persons, and to prescribe their qualifications;

15 (3-) To acquire and hold, and to dispose of, real and personal property,
16 and to construct, repair, remodel and remove buildings in the manner pre-
17 scribed for trustees of school districts;

18 (4-) To contract for the acquisition, purchase or repair of buildings,
19 in the manner prescribed for trustees of school districts;

20 (5-) To dispose of real and personal property in the manner prescribed
21 for trustees of school districts;

22 (6-) To issue general obligation or revenue bonds in the manner now, or
23 as may be, prescribed by law;

24 (7-) To convey and transfer real property of the district upon which
25 no college buildings used for instruction are situated, to nonprofit cor-
26 porations, school districts, junior college housing commissions, counties
27 or municipalities, with or without consideration; to rent real or personal
28 property for the use of the college, its students or faculty, for such terms
29 as may be determined by the board of trustees; to lease real property of the
30 district not actually in use for college instructional purposes for such
31 terms as may be determined by the board; and to lease real property and im-
32 provements to the Idaho state building authority, for a term not to exceed
33 fifty (50) years, with or without consideration, and to enter into agree-
34 ments with the Idaho state building authority for the Idaho state building
35 authority to provide a facility, pursuant to section 67-6410, Idaho Code;

36 (8-) To acquire, hold~~7~~ and dispose of~~7~~ water rights;

37 (9-) To accept grants or gifts of money, materials or property of any
38 kind from any governmental agency, or from any person, firm or association,
39 on such terms as may be determined by the granter;

40 (10-) To cooperate with any governmental agency, or any person, firm or
41 association in the conduct of any educational program; to accept grants from

1 any source for the conduct of such program; and to conduct such program on, or
2 off, campus;

3 (11-) To invest any funds of the district in such securities, and apply
4 the interest or profits from such investment, as prescribed for the invest-
5 ment of the funds, and the application of the interest or profits, in the case
6 of school district boards of trustees.
