AN ACT

1 APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION FOR THE IDAHO STATE
2 CAPITOL COMMISSION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017; MAKING A CASH TRANSFER; PRO-
3 VIDING REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY FOR DEDICATED FUNDS; AND PROVIDING
4 LEGISLATIVE INTENT.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

7 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Adminis-
8 tration for the Idaho State Capitol Commission, the following amounts to be
9 expended for the designated expense classes, from the listed funds for the
10 period July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017:

20 SECTION 2. CASH TRANSFER. There is hereby appropriated to the Depart-
21 ment of Administration for the Capitol Commission and the State Controller
22 shall transfer \$200,000 from the Capitol Maintenance Reserve Fund to the
23 Capitol Commission Operating Fund, on July 1, 2016, or as soon thereafter as
24 practicable, for the period July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017.

25 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY. There is hereby reappropriated
26 to the Department of Administration for the Idaho State Capitol Commission
27 any unexpended and unencumbered balances of moneys in the Capitol Commission
28 Operating Fund as appropriated for fiscal year 2016, to be used for nonrecur-
29 ring expenditures in the Capitol Commission Operating Fund, for the period
30 July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017.

31 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. The director of the Department of Ad-
32 ministration shall prepare a maintenance schedule for the Idaho State Capi-
33 tol Building. The director shall present the schedule and a plan to imple-
34 ment the schedule to the Legislative Council in the fall of 2016. The main-
35 tenance schedule shall include, but not be limited to, an annual plan as well
36 as a five-year plan to address routine maintenance, repairs and upkeep of the
37 Statehouse and its grounds.
