1 RELATING TO APPROPRIATIONS, DISTRIBUTIONS AND TRANSFERS OF IDAHO MILLENNIUM
2 FUNDS; APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE STATE TREASURER FOR DISTRIBUTION TO
3 THE AMERICAN LUNG ASSOCIATION OF IDAHO FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017; APPROPRI-
4 ATING MONEYS TO THE STATE TREASURER FOR DISTRIBUTION TO THE IDAHO ASSO-

36 MOUTH CAMPAIGN FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017; APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE STATE
37 BOARD OF EDUCATION AND THE BOARD OF REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF IDAHO
38 FOR AN AWARENESS PROGRAM ON ELECTRONIC DEVICES USED TO INGEST NICOTINE
39 AND THC BY YOUTH FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017; PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN UNEXPENDED
40 AND UNENCUMBERED BALANCE OF MONEYS SHALL REVERT TO THE IDAHO MILLEN-
41 NIUM INCOME FUND AT THE END OF FISCAL YEAR 2017; AND TRANSFERRING ANY
42 REMAINING UNEXPENDED AND UNENCUMBERED BALANCE OF MONEYS IN THE IDAHO
43 MILLENNIUM INCOME FUND TO THE IDAHO MILLENNIUM PERMANENT ENDOWMENT FUND
44 AT THE END OF FISCAL YEAR 2017.

1 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

2 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated \$202,000 from the Idaho Mil-
3 lennium Income Fund to the State Treasurer for distribution to the Ameri-
4 can Lung Association in Idaho for the period July 1, 2016, through June 30,
5 2017. The purpose of this grant is to provide youth tobacco prevention ser-
6 vices to Idaho youth through participation in three (3) American Lung As-
7 sociation programs statewide: Teens Against Tobacco Use (TATU), to train
8 teens in grades 8 through 12 to provide tobacco prevention presentations in
9 grades 4 through 7; Support Teens Against Nicotine Dependency (STAND), which
10 provides mini-grants, training and technical support to Idaho youth groups
11 to engage in community awareness and policy improvement projects regarding
12 tobacco; and adult facilitator training for Not-On-Tobacco (N-O-T), a smok-
13 ing cessation program designed specifically for youth under the age of 18
14 years.

15 SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated \$600,000 from the Idaho Millen-
16 nium Income Fund to the State Treasurer for distribution to the Idaho Asso-
17 ciation of Counties for the period July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017. The
18 purpose of this grant is to establish four (4) additional Community Recov-
19 ery Centers that will provide a safe place for individuals to go and find peer
20 support for Idahoans with behavioral health needs. These centers are to be
21 located in Bannock County, Bonneville County, Kootenai County and Nez Perce
22 County.

23 SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated \$50,000 from the Millennium In-
24 come Fund to the State Treasurer for distribution to the PEER Wellness Cen-
25 ter, to be expended for the period July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017. These
26 funds are to be used solely for the continued operations of the recovery cen-
27 ter in Ada County and none of these funds are to be provided to the Idaho Asso-
28 ciation of Counties.

29 SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated \$50,000 from the Millennium In-
30 come Fund to the State Treasurer for distribution to the Canyon County Com-
31 munity Clinic, to be expended for the period July 1, 2016, through June 30,
32 2017. These funds are to be used solely for the continued operations of the
33 recovery center in Canyon County and none of these funds are to be provided to
34 the Idaho Association of Counties.

35 SECTION 5. There is hereby appropriated \$50,000 from the Millennium In-
36 come Fund to the State Treasurer for distribution to Recovery Idaho, to be
37 expended for the period July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017. These funds are
38 to be used solely for the continued operations of the recovery center in Gem
39 County and none of these funds are to be provided to the Idaho Association of
40 Counties.

41 SECTION 6. There is hereby appropriated \$50,000 from the Millennium
42 Income Fund to the State Treasurer for distribution to the Sojourners' Al-
43 liance, to be expended for the period July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017.
44 These funds are to be used solely for the continued operations of the recov-

1 ery center in Latah County and none of these funds are to be provided to the
2 Idaho Association of Counties.

3 SECTION 7. There is hereby appropriated and, at the request of the State
4 Treasurer, the State Controller shall transfer \$750,000 from the Idaho Mil-
5 lennium Income Fund to the Idaho Public Health Districts for the period July
6 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017. The purpose of this grant is to continue the
7 Public Health District Millennium Fund cessation program. Through this pro-
8 gram, high-quality, best-practice tobacco cessation programs are provided
9 statewide at no cost to Idahoans who want to quit smoking, with a primary em-
10 phasis on youth and pregnant women.

11 SECTION 8. There is hereby appropriated \$194,200 from the Idaho Millen-
12 nium Income Fund to the State Treasurer for distribution to the American Can-
13 cer Society, Cancer Action Network, for the period July 1, 2016, through June
14 30, 2017. The purpose of this grant is to perform outreach to underserved
15 women and educate them about the connection between tobacco use and cancer,
16 the need for cancer screenings, and cessation tools available.

17 SECTION 9. There is hereby appropriated \$495,600 from the Idaho Millen-
18 nium Income Fund to the State Treasurer for distribution to the Idaho Preven-
19 tion Project for the period July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017. The purpose
20 of this grant is to continue the "Not Even Once" campaign to discourage the
21 use of methamphetamine and to continue with a prescription drug educational
22 component. The purpose of this grant is to continue teen outreach through
23 digital media, school presentations and community engagement activities.

24 SECTION 10. There is hereby appropriated \$50,000 from the Idaho Millen-
25 nium Income Fund to the State Treasurer for distribution to the Idaho Youth
26 Ranch for the period July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017. The purpose of
27 this grant is to support programs at Anchor House, which is a family ther-
28 apy and support center in Coeur d'Alene that serves children, teens and fam-
29 ilies throughout northern Idaho. The grant would provide personnel funding
30 for staff to provide an array of services that can be bundled for an overall
31 impact, to provide services to children and families in need of behavioral
32 and/or psychological therapy, and to provide substance abuse prevention for
33 children who are at a greater risk of abusing drugs and alcohol.

34 SECTION 11. There is hereby appropriated \$120,000 from the Idaho Mil-
35 lennium Income Fund to the State Treasurer for distribution to Jannus, Inc.,
36 for the period July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017. The purpose of the grant
37 is to provide direct services to individuals who are experiencing emotional
38 crises by offering them emotional support and access to resources that will
39 prevent self-harm and reduce the number of completed suicides.

40 SECTION 12. There is hereby appropriated \$194,600 from the Idaho Mil-
41 lennium Income Fund to the State Treasurer for distribution to the Saint
42 Alphonsus Regional Medical Center for the period July 1, 2016, through June
43 30, 2017. The purpose of the grant is to support tobacco-free living. Cessa-
44 tion services will provide clinical education to tobacco users to increase

1 their understanding of physiological and psychological nicotine addic-
2 tion, advise tobacco users of the comparative benefits of pharmacotherapy
3 interventions, link tobacco users to medical providers for clinical assis-
4 tance, increase medical providers' tobacco cessation literacy, and increase
5 medical provider referrals and follow-up to prompt patients to enroll in
6 cessation counseling.

7 SECTION 13. There is hereby appropriated \$423,400 from the Idaho Mil-
8 lennium Income Fund to the State Treasurer for distribution to the Boys
9 & Girls Club of Idaho for the period July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017.
10 This grant is for the Youth Empowerment Project, which is intended to build
11 self-esteem, instill good character and citizenship, improve academic
12 skills, and develop positive relationships for youth ages 6-18. The project
13 offers a holistic youth development service delivery system versus a sin-
14 gle-strategy approach to prevention of at-risk behaviors. This grant will
15 serve a minimum of 3,300 youth who attend club facilities.

16 SECTION 14. There is hereby appropriated and, at the request of the
17 State Treasurer, the State Controller shall transfer \$1,062,800 from the
18 Idaho Millennium Income Fund to the Idaho Department of Juvenile Corrections
19 for the Youth Prevention and Cessation programs for the period July 1, 2016,
20 through June 30, 2017. The purpose of this grant is to support programs that
21 prevent and reduce the use of tobacco and other substances by youth.

22 SECTION 15. There is hereby appropriated and, at the request of the
23 State Treasurer, the State Controller shall transfer \$94,000 from the Idaho
24 Millennium Income Fund to the Idaho State Police for tobacco permittee com-
25 pliance inspections to be expended for the period July 1, 2016, through June
26 30, 2017. The purpose of this grant is to assist the Idaho State Police and
27 the Department of Health and Welfare with the cost of tobacco permittee com-
28 pliance inspections as required by law.

29 SECTION 16. There is hereby appropriated and, at the request of the
30 State Treasurer, the State Controller shall transfer \$1,859,200 from the
31 Idaho Millennium Income Fund to the Idaho Department of Correction for the
32 Community-Based Substance Abuse Treatment Services Program for the period
33 July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017. The purpose of this grant is to continue
34 coordination, assessment and community-based substance abuse treatment and
35 recovery support services for felony offenders in lieu of incarceration in a
36 state facility.

37 SECTION 17. There is hereby appropriated and, at the request of the
38 State Treasurer, the State Controller shall transfer \$2,706,700 from the
39 Idaho Millennium Income Fund to the Idaho Department of Health and Welfare
40 for Project Filter in the Physical Health Services Program for the period
41 July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017. The purpose of this grant is to pro-
42 vide free nicotine replacement therapy medication (nicotine patches, gum
43 and lozenges), web-based cessation services and telephonic cessation coun-
44 seling services to assist people in quitting tobacco use. These funds will
45 help residents who are attempting to quit tobacco use and who cannot afford

1 to pay for these services and medications on their own. This funding will
2 also be used to promote the services through television, radio and print.
3 It will help reduce the burden tobacco use places on taxpayers and reduce
4 tobacco-related illnesses and deaths. The grant will also be used for a
5 counter-marketing program that includes social media, grassroots marketing
6 and other activities such as sponsorships and community outreach.

7 SECTION 18. There is hereby appropriated \$24,000 from the Idaho Mil-
8 lennium Income Fund to the State Treasurer for distribution to the Community
9 Coalitions of Idaho for the period July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017. The
10 purpose of this grant is to assist Idaho communities with the establishment
11 of community-supported coalitions that aim to prevent and reduce substance
12 abuse in the community.

13 SECTION 19. There is hereby appropriated \$84,400 from the Idaho Millen-
14 nium Income Fund to the State Treasurer for distribution to the Idaho Academy
15 of Family Physicians for the period July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017. The
16 purpose of this grant is for the Tar Wars Program, which is designed to teach
17 children how to make positive decisions regarding their health. Tar Wars is
18 a tobacco-free education program for students in grades 4 and 5.

19 SECTION 20. There is hereby appropriated and, at the request of the
20 State Treasurer, the State Controller shall transfer \$127,700 from the Idaho
21 Millennium Income Fund to the State Board of Education for Lewis-Clark State
22 College for the Fresh Mouth Campaign for the period July 1, 2016, through
23 June 30, 2017. The purpose of this grant is to educate participants about the
24 impacts of smoking on oral health and to motivate clients to reduce or cease
25 smoking.

26 SECTION 21. There is hereby appropriated and, at the request of the
27 State Treasurer, the State Controller shall transfer \$398,400 from the Idaho
28 Millennium Income Fund to the State Board of Education and the Board of Re-
29 gents of the University of Idaho to provide for an e-cigarette awareness
30 campaign for the period July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017. The purpose of
31 this grant is to develop, test and implement an awareness program on elec-
32 tronic devices used for ingesting nicotine and tetrahydrocannabinol (THC)
33 by youth. The project will use social media and coalition building in three
34 (3) of Idaho's border communities: Coeur d'Alene, Moscow and Lewiston.

35 SECTION 22. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,
36 on June 30, 2017, or as soon thereafter as is practicable, any remaining un-
37 expended and unencumbered balance of moneys appropriated in Sections 7, 14,
38 15, 16, 17, 20 and 21 of this act shall be reverted to the Idaho Millennium In-
39 come Fund.

40 SECTION 23. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,
41 on June 30, 2017, or as soon thereafter as is practicable, the State Con-
42 troller, at the request of the State Treasurer, shall transfer any remaining
43 unexpended and unencumbered balance of moneys in the Idaho Millennium Income
44 Fund to the Idaho Millennium Permanent Endowment Fund.
