A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND RECOGNIZING IDAHO PEACE OFFICERS FOR
THEIR SERVICE TO THE STATE.

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

WHEREAS, the peace officers of Idaho have worked diligently and self-
lessly on behalf of the people of Idaho regardless of the peril or hazard to
