

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS24952

This legislation will change the requirement for front license plates on certain vehicles. Some vehicles are not manufactured to hold a license plate on the front. Buyers of these vehicles are required to purchase and install after-market plate holding devices and/or modify the front of their vehicles to accommodate a front plate. This legislation allows the vehicle owner to display only one plate attached to the rear of the vehicle.

FISCAL NOTE

There is no fiscal impact on the state General Fund because this is a regulatory change and requires no additional oversight by any state agency on the General Fund budget. There will be a minimal impact on certain dedicated funds such as peace officer training and ISTARS and county justice funds because of fewer citations and fines. At most, based on 2016 citation numbers for failure to display a front plate or registration sticker at 265 or less, there would be an impact of no more than \$17,755 of losses in revenue from fines.
