AN ACT

1 RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION; AMENDING SECTION 49-402, IDAHO
2 CODE, TO REMOVE REFERENCE TO CERTAIN STATUTORY PROVISIONS AND TO MAKE
3 TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS; REPEALING SECTIONS 49-415C, 49-415E, 49-416A,
4 49-416B, 49-416C, 49-416D, 49-416E, 49-417E, 49-418E, 49-419B,
5 49-419D, 49-420G, 49-420H AND 49-420I, IDAHO CODE, RELATING TO CERTAIN
6 SPECIAL PLATES; AMENDING SECTION 49-450, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE A FEE
7 PROVISION, TO REVISE PROVISIONS REGARDING THE TRANSFER OF CERTAIN FUNDS
8 FROM THE PLATE MANUFACTURING ACCOUNT TO THE HIGHWAY DISTRIBUTION AC-
9 COUNT AND TO MAKE A TECHNICAL CORRECTION; AND AMENDING SECTION 49-450A,
10 IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE FOR THE TRANSFER OF CERTAIN FUNDS FROM THE PLATE
11 MANUFACTURING ACCOUNT TO THE STATE HIGHWAY ACCOUNT.

13 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

14 SECTION 1. That Section 49-402, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
15 amended to read as follows:

16 49-402. ANNUAL REGISTRATION. (1) The annual fee for operating each
17 pickup truck, each neighborhood electric vehicle and each other motor ve-
18 hicle having a maximum gross weight not in excess of eight thousand (8,000)
19 pounds and that complies with the federal motor vehicle safety standards as
20 defined in section 49-107, Idaho Code, shall be:

21 Vehicles one (1) and two (2) years old\$69.00
22 Vehicles three (3) and four (4) years old\$57.00
23 Vehicles five (5) and six (6) years old\$57.00
24 Vehicles seven (7) and eight (8) years old\$45.00
25 Vehicles over eight (8) years old\$45.00

26 There shall be twelve (12) registration periods, starting in January
27 for holders of validation registration stickers numbered 1, and proceed-
28 ing consecutively through December for holders of validation registration
29 stickers numbered 12, each of which shall start on the first day of a calendar
30 month and end on the last day of the twelfth month from the first day of the
31 beginning month. Registration periods shall expire midnight on the last day
32 of the registration period in the year designated by the validation regis-
33 tration sticker. The numeral digit on the validation registration stickers
34 shall, as does the registration card, fix the registration period under the
35 staggered registration system for the purpose of reregistration and notice
36 of expiration.

37 A vehicle that has once been registered for any of the above-designated
38 periods shall, upon reregistration, be registered for the period bearing the
39 same number, and the registration card shall show and be the exclusive proof
40 of the expiration date of registration and licensing. Vehicles may be ini-
41 tially registered for less than a twelve (12) month period, or for more than a
42 twelve (12) month period, and the fee prorated on a monthly basis if the frac-

1 tional registration tends to fulfill the purpose of the monthly series reg-
2 istration system.

3 (2) For all school buses operated either by a nonprofit, nonpublic
4 school or operated pursuant to a service contract with a school district for
5 transporting children to or from school or in connection with school_ap-
6 proved activities, the annual fee shall be twenty-four dollars (\$24.00) and
7 shall be subject to staggered registration for the purpose of reregistration
8 and notice of expiration.

9 (3) For all motorcycles and motor-driven cycles ~~which~~ that comply with
10 the federal motor vehicle safety standards, operated upon the public high-
11 ways, the annual fee shall be nineteen dollars (\$19.00) and shall be subject
12 to staggered registration for the purpose of reregistration and notice of
13 expiration.

14 (4) For operation of an all-terrain vehicle, utility type vehicle or
15 motorbike, excluding a motorbike with an engine displacement of fifty (50)
16 cubic centimeters or less, on city, county or highway district roads or
17 highways open to such use, a restricted vehicle license plate fee pursuant
18 to section 49-450, Idaho Code, shall be paid. In addition, the registration
19 fee specified in section 67-7122, Idaho Code, shall be paid as provided in
20 section 67-7122, Idaho Code. The registration and restricted vehicle li-
21 cense plate exemption provided in section 49-426(2), Idaho Code, applies
22 to all-terrain vehicles, utility type vehicles, motorbikes and motorcycles
23 used for the purposes described in ~~subsection (2) of~~ section 49-426(2),
24 Idaho Code. Nonresidents shall be allowed to purchase a restricted vehicle
25 license plate and sticker for an all-terrain vehicle, utility type vehicle
26 or motorbike.

27 (5) For all motor homes, the fee shall be as specified in subsection (1)
28 of this section and shall be in addition to the fees provided for in section
29 49-445, Idaho Code.

30 (6) Registration fees shall not be subject to refund.

31 (7) A financial institution or repossession service contracted to
32 a financial institution repossessing vehicles under the terms of a secu-
33 rity agreement shall move the vehicle from the place of repossession to the
34 financial institution's place of business on a repossession plate. The
35 repossession plate shall also be used for demonstrating the vehicle to a
36 prospective purchaser for a period not to exceed ninety-six (96) hours. The
37 registration fees for repossession plates shall be as required in subsection
38 (1) of this section for a vehicle one (1) and two (2) years old. All other
39 fees required under chapter 4, title 49, Idaho Code, shall be in addition to
40 the registration fee. The repossession plate shall be subject to staggered
41 registration for the purpose of reregistration and notice of expiration.

42 (8) A wrecker or towing business engaged in the process of towing motor-
43 ized vehicles, which have been wrecked, abandoned, salvaged or may be dis-
44 abled, may apply for a wrecker plate to be displayed on those vehicles being
45 towed, provided the power unit is properly registered under this chapter.
46 The registration fees for wrecker plates shall be as required in subsection
47 (1) of this section for a vehicle one (1) and two (2) years old. All other
48 fees required under chapter 4, title 49, Idaho Code, shall be in addition to
49 the registration fee and shall be subject to staggered registration for the
50 purpose of reregistration and notice of expiration.

1 (9) In addition to the annual registration fee in this section, there
 2 shall be an initial program fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) and an an-
 3 nual program fee of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) for all special license plate
 4 programs for those license plates issued pursuant to sections 49-404A,
 5 49-407, 49-408, 49-409, 49-414, 49-416, 49-418 and 49-418D, Idaho Code. For
 6 special plates issued pursuant to sections 49-406 and 49-406A, Idaho Code,
 7 there shall be an initial program fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) but
 8 there shall be no annual renewal fee. For special plates issued pursuant
 9 to sections ~~49-415C, 49-415D, 49-415E, 49-416A, 49-416B, 49-416C, 49-416D,~~
 10 ~~49-416E,~~ 49-417, 49-417A, 49-417B, 49-417C, 49-417D, ~~49-417E,~~ 49-418A,
 11 49-418B, 49-418C, ~~49-418E,~~ 49-419, 49-419A, ~~49-419B,~~ 49-419C, ~~49-419D,~~
 12 49-419E, 49-420, 49-420A, 49-420B, 49-420C, 49-420D, 49-420E, ~~49-420G,~~
 13 ~~49-420H, 49-420I,~~ 49-420J, 49-420K, 49-420L, 49-420M, 49-420N and 49-420O,
 14 Idaho Code, and any new special plate program effective on and after January
 15 1, 2013, pursuant to section 49-402D, Idaho Code, there shall be an initial
 16 program fee of thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) and an annual program fee of
 17 twenty-five dollars (\$25.00). The fees contained in this subsection shall
 18 be applicable to all new special plate programs and shall be subject to stag-
 19 gered registration for the purpose of reregistration and notice of expira-
 20 tion. The initial program fee and the annual program fee shall be deposited
 21 in the state highway account and shall be used to fund the cost of administra-
 22 tion of special license plate programs, unless otherwise specified by law.

23 (10) Any vehicle that does not meet federal motor vehicle safety stan-
 24 dards shall not be registered and shall not be permitted to operate on public
 25 highways of the state, as defined in section 40-117, Idaho Code, unless oth-
 26 erwise specifically authorized.

27 (11) In addition to annual registration fees as provided in this sec-
 28 tion, registrants may pay a fee to purchase an Idaho state parks passport
 29 authorizing resident motor vehicle entry into all Idaho state parks. Reg-
 30 istrants may pay the fee for a one (1) year or two (2) year period of time.
 31 The fee shall be ten dollars (\$10.00) for one (1) year and twenty dollars
 32 (\$20.00) for two (2) years. All fees collected pursuant to this subsection
 33 shall be deposited into the park and recreation fund and shall be subject to
 34 appropriation. Fees collected pursuant to this subsection shall not be con-
 35 sidered a motor vehicle registration fee as provided in section 17, article
 36 VII, of the constitution of the state of Idaho.

37 SECTION 2. That Section [49-415C](#), Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
 38 repealed.

39 SECTION 3. That Section [49-415E](#), Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
 40 repealed.

41 SECTION 4. That Section [49-416A](#), Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
 42 repealed.

43 SECTION 5. That Section [49-416B](#), Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
 44 repealed.

45 SECTION 6. That Section [49-416C](#), Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
 46 repealed.

1 SECTION 7. That Section [49-416D](#), Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
2 repealed.

3 SECTION 8. That Section [49-416E](#), Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
4 repealed.

5 SECTION 9. That Section [49-417E](#), Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
6 repealed.

7 SECTION 10. That Section [49-418E](#), Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
8 repealed.

9 SECTION 11. That Section [49-419B](#), Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
10 repealed.

11 SECTION 12. That Section [49-419D](#), Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
12 repealed.

13 SECTION 13. That Section [49-420G](#), Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
14 repealed.

15 SECTION 14. That Section [49-420H](#), Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
16 repealed.

17 SECTION 15. That Section [49-420I](#), Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
18 repealed.

19 SECTION 16. That Section 49-450, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
20 amended to read as follows:

21 49-450. ADDITIONAL FEE FOR EACH PLATE ISSUED. In addition to the ve-
22 hicle registration fee provided by law, whenever any plate is issued for
23 vehicle registration, there shall be charged a fee of three dollars and
24 seventy-five cents (\$3.~~00~~75) per plate, which shall be deposited into the
25 plate manufacturing account created in section 49-450A, Idaho Code. The
26 actual cost of producing and distributing license plates and the fifty cents
27 (~~\$.50~~¢) per plate fee designated to the Idaho heritage trust for the use
28 of the copyrighted design provided for in section 49-443(1), Idaho Code,
29 shall be paid from the plate manufacturing account. The difference between
30 deposits into the account and disbursements out of the account not ~~required~~
31 anticipated for future ~~obligations~~ production cost increases, shall be
32 transferred by the state controller from the plate manufacturing account to
33 the highway distribution account as established in section 40-701, Idaho
34 Code, for apportionment as designated in that section. Funds designated to
35 the Idaho heritage trust shall be matched with equal funds from other sources
36 for funding projects designed to preserve Idaho's historic resources.

37 SECTION 17. That Section 49-450A, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
38 amended to read as follows:

39 49-450A. PLATE MANUFACTURING ACCOUNT. There is hereby created in the
40 state treasury an account to be known as the "plate manufacturing account"

1 for the purpose of paying the actual cost to produce and distribute license
2 plates and to pay costs related to use of the centennial design on the li-
3 cense plate. All moneys in this account are hereby continuously appropri-
4 ated to the department. Any additional funds required to pay plate produc-
5 tion and distribution costs will be transferred by the state controller from
6 the state highway account. Once an adequate cash balance has accumulated in
7 the plate manufacturing account, the state controller will transfer funds
8 from the plate manufacturing account to reimburse the state highway account.
