5	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

- SECTION 1. That Chapter 37, Title 33, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and des-
- ignated as Section 33-3728, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:
 - 33-3728. CAMPUS FREE SPEECH. An institution of higher education that receives funding from the state shall not impose restrictions on the time, place and manner of student speech that is protected by the first amendment of the United States constitution or section 9, article I of the Idaho constitution, unless the restrictions:
 - (1) Are reasonable;

- (2) Are justified without reference to the content of the regulated speech;
 - (3) Are narrowly tailored to serve a significant government interest;
- (4) Leave open ample alternative channels for communication of the information; and
- (5) Do not establish free speech zones or otherwise limit free speech to certain areas of the institution's campus.
