2023 Targets for Key Metrics



- 60% of students reach college ready benchmark
- 95% of students graduate high school
- 80% of high school graduates will have participated in Advanced Opportunities
- 3% of high school graduates will graduate with an associate's degree
- 60% of high school graduates "go on"

By 2025, 60% of Idahoans age 25-34 achieve 1, 2, 4 or more




