

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS26710

Manufacturers of all terrain vehicles (ATV) and utility type vehicles (UTV) wish to develop new products which are more capable and stable models of these types of vehicles. To do so requires more width and weight than current law allows. Current Idaho statutory definitions limit ATVs to 50 inches and UTVs to 74 inches. This bill would increase maximum widths by 5 inches for ATVs (up to 55 inches) and 6 inches for UTVs (up to 80 inches). The bill also deletes the current statutory weight maximum for UTVs which is 2000 pounds, to be consistent with House Bill 24. There being no present statutory weight maximum for ATVs, the bill does nothing to change that status quo.

FISCAL NOTE

This bill would have no impact on the General Fund because it defines the size and weight of ATV and UTV vehicles and has no effect on fees.
