## SENATE BILL NO. 1034, As Amended

## BY HEALTH AND WELFARE COMMITTEE

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2	RELATING TO HEALTH INSURANCE; AMENDING CHAPTER 18, TITLE 41, IDAHO CODE,
3	BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 41-1853, IDAHO CODE, TO ESTABLISH PRO-
4	VISIONS REGARDING ANTICANCER MEDICATIONS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
5	DATE.

- Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:
- SECTION 1. That Chapter 18, Title 41, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a NEW SECTION, to be known and des-9 ignated as Section 41-1853, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:
  - 41-1853. ANTICANCER MEDICATIONS. (1) For purposes of this section:
  - (a) "Anticancer medication" means a drug or biologic used to kill, slow, or prevent the growth of cancerous cells, whether administered orally, intravenously, or by injection.
  - (b) "Health benefit plan" shall have the same meaning as provided in section 41-5903, Idaho Code.
  - (2) A health benefit plan covering food and drug administration approved anticancer medications determined to be necessary by a licensed oncologist, ordered by a licensed oncologist, and meeting health benefit plan coverage criteria shall not assign a higher copayment, deductible, or coinsurance amount for a patient-administered anticancer medication than for an injected or intravenously administered anticancer medication.
  - (3) A health benefit plan covering an anticancer medication is not required to classify the anticancer medication as a medical benefit.
  - (4) A health benefit plan that provides coverage of anticancer medications cannot comply with the provisions of subsection (2) of this section by:
    - (a) Increasing the copayment, deductible, or coinsurance amount required for an anticancer medication covered under the health benefit plan; or
    - (b) Reclassifying benefits with respect to anticancer medications.
- SECTION 2. This act shall be in full force and effect on and after Jan-30 31 uary 1, 2020.
